The Allied Arts Council of Lethbridge (AAC) is a not-for-profit umbrella organization working to advance the arts in Lethbridge. We are looking for a motivated, outgoing, creative, disciplined, and resourceful individual to provide support for a busy slate of summer programs, events, and activities.

The successful candidate will provide support for Summer Art Camps and Youth Art Week. Duties include assisting with student supervision, aiding students with art projects, and maintaining classrooms and supplies. This person will also provide general facility and studio support when classes aren't running. An interest in working in the not-for-profit sector will make you an excellent candidate for this position.

The position being offered is funded in part by a Canada Summer Jobs grant. The Canada Summer Jobs grant requires that the successful applicant be:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age;
- A Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act;
- Legally entitled to work in Canada

The successful candidate will be required to work 37.5 hours a week as scheduled. The pay rate for this position is \$21.00/hr. The term position will end no later than August 30, 2024. A recent police information check with a vulnerable sector check must be provided.
