The Allied Arts Council of Lethbridge (AAC) is a not-for-profit umbrella organization working to advance the arts in Lethbridge. We seek an outgoing, motivated, creative, disciplined and resourceful individual interested in working in Lethbridge's community arts centre, Casa.

The successful candidate will be responsible for instruction in core clay programming, and the position requires the ability to teach clay wheel and handbuilding. The following skills are assets but can be taught on the job: kiln loading, glaze chemistry, and clay recycling. Duties include:

- Providing instruction for 3D core classes, workshops, and birthday parties.
- Maintaining order in instruction and studio spaces.
- Assisting facility users with room access and use of equipment.
- Providing support and information to facility users while ensuring their general safety.

The position being offered is a permanent, full-time position. The successful candidate will work 40 hours a week; evening and weekend work is required. A recent criminal record check and vulnerable sector check must be provided. The wage is \$23/hour.
